What is the Sports Premium?

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013-2020. This money is coming directly to Head teachers to spend on improving the quality and provision of sport and PE for the primary aged pupils in their schools.

How does this effect and impact Battledown Centre for Children & Families?

All pupils where practicable will access a breadth of physical activity.

- Develop a greater breadth of resources so that PE activities can be delivered more effectively.
- Ensuring ALL pupils, regardless of their physical needs, are able to access, make progress and enjoy the PE curriculum.
- Providing a clear and structured PE curriculum across the whole school.
- Develop a consistent method of PE assessment across the whole school.
- Through in-house staff training, we will improve the quality and consistency of provision and help improve staff confidence in delivering PE.
- Provide specialist provision and opportunities in PE through specialist coaching (i.e. Riding for the Disabled).

Reason for carried forward - COVID 19 restrictions on ability to carry on with activities during lockdown

Plan for money carried over - Purchase a new PE bench and install additional equipment in Yellow garden to increase and engage children in their physical ability for those in Key Stage 1 children.

The ongoing COVID 19 restrictions will limit offsite activities and therefore the need to adapt and strengthen physical skills for children will be more in demand. An installation of outdoor equipment to improve balance and confidence will be carried out over August & October 2020.
